The Journalism minor is not being substantively revised; rather, this revision corrects a clerical ambiguity and adds a new course to the menu.

Identify other units affected by the proposed changes:

Journalism is administered by the English department in collaboration with the Communication department; COMM supports this change.

Describe the rationale for the proposed program change(s):

The current minor allows students to count ENGL464 or COMM364. ENGL464 was listed in error: "Internship in Professional Writing" should not automatically count toward the Journalism minor. Instead of allowing ENGL469 "Internship" and COMM364 to count toward the minor when appropriate ("by permission of instructor"), we have proposed a unique number for Journalism students: JOUR464.

JOUR311 is a proposed, permanent version of a very successful experimental course, JOUR367 "Convergence Journalism."
