Proposed modifications are meant to streamline and clarify (e.g. combine credit totals where possible). The greatest change is eliminating a distinction made in years past – and difficult to "define" - between Western and non-Western languages in the Third Language component of the major. Additionally, the proposed revisions will reduce the total number of credits in this major concentration, bringing it in line with other concentrations in our Department.
