Hello, Barry.

As chair of the Senate Coordinating Committee on Education I am writing to tell you that we have met to consider your application (GRD0281) and would like to request some additional supporting materials. Since this is a new program, we would like to see the "Budgetary needs" (as specified in Section C.VI.C. of the Approval Process for Provisional and Permanent Academic Programs; <http://www.udel.edu/facsen/course/index.html>) and a short description of how they will be met (i.e. by Dept., college, or external funds). We also are requesting that you provide a letter from the chair and/or dean stating that they will provide funds for all the budgetary needs (e.g. S-contracts) through the provisional period (5 years), since it is unusual to base a new program solely on S-contracts.

Your New Program Policy Document had in Section VIII (Appendices) a list that included letters and a budget. There were no documents attached to that effect, so they may have been inadvertently omitted.

Lastly, your Resolution states "provisionally, for 4 years," but it should state for 5 years, so we will need a revised resolution, as well.

We will proceed with your application as soon as we receive these additional required materials.
