Describe the rationale for the proposed program change(s): The motion to disestablish the MA program in Counseling in Higher Education comes moved and seconded by the HDFS graduate committee and has been voted on by the HDFS faculty.*

The decision to disestablish the MA program, Counseling in Higher Education is based on several concurrently significant factors. An external review of the graduate programs in 2007-2008 in Human Development and Family Studies, questioned the fit of the MA program with the other departmental offerings. The reviewers indicated that with the exception of one other program in the country, College Counseling programs are never part of the offerings of HDFS departments and dilute the potential for offering focused, appropriate programs of study. The reviewers also pointed to the lack of faculty associated with the program. Currently, most courses are taught on S-contract and there is only one full time faculty member affiliated with the MA program. With the disestablishment of the MA program, this faculty member's expertise can be better utilized to strengthen the non-profit leadership concentration of the MS program. The significant reliance on S-contracts also translates into a very high cost program, which only brings in minimal tuition revenue from students. Lastly, the presence of a very similar program in the School of Education, the MEd in Higher Education Administration, creates a competitive environment for admitting similar students within the same college.

The Counseling in Higher Education program is currently housed in HDFS in the new College of Education and Human Development. As the College moves forward, disestablishing the Counseling in Higher Education will allow resources to be freed up that permit us to hire faculty in high priority academic areas. Terminating the MA program also allows us to build on the strengths identified in the external review of HDFS, and to achieve a stronger national and international presence in human development and family studies.

We plan on providing all necessary classes for the second year students in 2011-2012 so that the students can graduate with their MA degree. However, we will not be admitting any new students this year.

Discontinuing the MA program is not an indication that HDFS would be opposed to contributing toward a master's program in higher education within the College, in collaboration with the School of Education, if resources were made available to offer such a program in the future.
