RE: Proposed Curriculum Changes for HRIM major

The HRIM Department, with the support of the Dean, proposes to change the required Economics courses for the major from ECON100 to both ECON151 and 152. This involves a change in required seats in ECON151 and 152 of about 70 students – the equivalent of two sections. We can accommodate the increase in ECON151 by reducing capacity in ECON100 at no additional resource cost. The increase in demand for ECON152 requires funding for two additional sections, because this course is already at capacity. Rick Andrews, Deputy Dean of the Lerner College, is aware of the resource need and has indicated that appropriate support for these new sections would be available to the department. With this assurance I am happy to support the revision of the HRIM curriculum.
