The instructor of ELEG 491 is in the Philosophy department. He asked us to make this change as it will better suit his teaching requirements.

Describe the rationale for the proposed program change(s):

We propose increasing the number of credits for ELEG 491, Ethics/Impacts of Engineering (a required course for BEE students) from two credits to three credits and making the corresponding change increasing the overall number of credits required for the BEE degree from 125 to 126.

The change to ELEG 491 brings the course into alignment with most other courses at the university, better accommodates the needs of the professor who teaches the course, and allows us to put greater emphasis on these essential topics (ethics, leadership, communications, teamwork, etc.).

126 credits is the same credit load as the Bachelors in Chemical Engineering and the Bachelors in Civil Engineering.

We intend to make the same changes to the Bachelors in Computer Engineering degree.
