Explanation of Change:

The UD DPT Program Faculty wish to follow the recommendations for standard pre-requisite courses required for admission as set forth by the Academic Council of the APTA, and as informed by the PTCAS Course Prerequisites Summary: 2011-12 Admissions Cycle. The movement toward standard prerequisite coursework will enable applicants to have an easier time identifying and completing necessary prerequisite coursework for multiple programs and will allow faculty advisors to better advise undergraduate students about requirements for pursuing physical therapy.
