Describe the rationale for the proposed program change(s):

Originally the Health Behavior Science Program had two concentration areas: Fitness Management or Leisure. The number of students in Leisure Services declined when Sports Management was developed as a major. The program was changed to eliminate concentrations and require a minor in 2009. Since the inception of Leisure Services Management Minor in 2009, there has been a slow decline in interest in the minor. It appears that the students are now taking other minors that have been recently developed (i.e. public health, disabilities minor). The Health Behavior Science faculty members have met and it was a unanimous decision to eliminate the minor.
