3	University of Delaware	Repeated class grade will appear on transcript along with original grade.
4	American University	"Freshman Forgiveness Rule" applies only to freshman who failed a course not due to violation of academic integrity. The repeated course must be taken within a year from the time the first class was taken. The second grade replaces the original failing grade.
5	Boston College	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
6	Boston University	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
7	Brown University	Repeated class' will appear on transcript. Brown does not have a GPA System. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
8	Carnegie Mellon	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
9	College of William & Mary	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
10	Columbia	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
11	Cornell	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
12	George Washington University	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.

13	Georgia Institute of Technology	"Grade Substitution" applies to first-time freshman who received a D or F within their first two terms in residence. Course must be repeated within first four terms of residence and an application for grade substitution must be made to Registrar's Office no later than course withdraw date. Original grade will appear on transcript with notation of exclusion of original grade from GPA calculation.
14	Lehigh University	"Repeating of Courses" applies to any student who wishes to repeat a course. The original grade is removed from GPA calculation, but remains on transcript. Students can also request to delete from record, through Registrar's Office.
15	Northeastern University	"Repeating a Course" applies to students who fail a course. Students may take a course, up to three times. However, colleges have specific policy based on the academic program. The new grade will replace the original grade.
16	NYU	The repeating of courses is determined by college and/or academic program/location.
17	Penn State - University Park	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
18	Syracuse	Policy on "Flagging". Students may repeat a course. Second grade will be included in GPA. Original grade will remain on transcript but can be excluded from GPA depending on college.
19	U Conn	Students may repeat a course once twice, first without approval and second with approval from the Dean of the School or College. No student may repeat a course for a third time. For a repeated course, the credit counts only once. Only the new grade is computed into the GPA, but the old grade still appears on the transcript.
20	U Md College Park	"Freshman and Transfer Exemption" Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript and may or may not be calculated along with the new grade in the GPA, depending on eligibility of exemption
21	U Mass Amherst	"Grade Forgiveness" policy, up to 5 courses. Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript but will not be calculated in the GPA. New grade will be calculated in GPA.
22	University of Michigan	The repeating of courses is determined by college and/or academic program/location.
23	University of Virginia	Students wanting to repeat a course must get permission from dean's office. Original course will appear on transcript and be calculated in GPA. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
24	UNC Chapel Hill	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.

25	University of Notre Dame	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
26	U Penn	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. Individual colleges determine the policy of retaking courses. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
27	U Pittsburgh	Students who want to repeat a course are advised to check with their respective school and need to submit appropriate forms. Students also have to meet the following requirements: Student must have earned a C- or lower, both classes must be taken at the University of Pittsburgh. Original course grade stays on transcript, but only the new grade is calculated into the GPA. Students are only allowed to repeat a course twice.
28	U Texas Austin	Students who want to repeat a course are advised to check with their respective school and need to submit appropriate forms. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
29	U Vermont	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
30	Villanova	"Repeat Freshman Year Policy". Students have the option of repeating the entire year. The grades from the bankrupted semester or year will not be included in the cumulative average (though a record of the semester's or year's work will remain on the transcript.)
31	Virginia Tech	Repeated class' grade will appear on transcript along with original grade. There is no "Forgiveness Policy" set in place.
32	Washington State University	Repeating courses graded C- or below. To improve the cumulative or resident grade point average, a student may only repeat courses in which a C- or below was received.
